HealthlinkNY would like to wish you a Happy New Year! Thanks to supporters like you, last year was a very successful year for us. Here is a look back at how we have grown as a business in our community:

- HealthlinkNY started 2015 by successfully completing a total system platform migration
- HealthlinkNY achieved official certification as a Qualified Entity (QE)
- HealthlinkNY finalized the merger between STHL and THINC, with each region's main office undergoing a physical location change
- HealthlinkNY launched a new public website
- HealthlinkNY developed the Health Action Priorities Network (HAPN) to oversee both the Southern Tier and Hudson Valley regional PHIP activities
- HealthlinkNY began coordinating with 4 regional Performing Provider Systems (PPS) to support NYS DSRIP efforts
- HealthlinkNY began successfully exchanging patient data through the Statewide Health Information Network of New York (SHIN-NY)
- HealthlinkNY's coverage region grew to include a new county (Chemung), bringing our total

A year in review: HealthlinkNY 2015 Statistics

Brought 27 new data contributing organizations live, which included 15 contributing hospitals, 7 ambulatory physician groups / practices, and 4 FQHCs

Increased the number of patients registered in the HIE by over 800k with roughly 1.2 million patient records added over the year

Increased the number of incoming clinical transactions to the HIE by nearly 3.2 million transactions per month

Raised total unique patient consents by over 183k, with more than 163k new patients choosing permit

Christina Galanis was featured in Westfair Online for her story about her recent experience as a patient in the emergency room and how the HIE might have helped.

A month ago, I went to the emergency

room with chest pains. Fortunately, I was not having a heart attack, as I feared. But the ER visit allowed me to experience our health care system as a patient. I discovered the ER had not yet completely entered the Information Age. While awaiting treatment, I was given pages and pages of forms to fill out: medical history, medications and allergies - all information that could be easily accessed online by connecting to my doctor's electronic health records. The ER staff had the ability to do that, if only they had known they could!

Both the hospital and my primary care doctor participate in HealthlinkNY, the regional health information exchange I helped found in 2002. It's a network that lets different electronic health records based on different platforms "talk" to each other while protecting patient privacy and keeping data secure.

Organizations now live with HealthlinkNY

Family Services of Chemung County Goes Live with Web Portal Access

Access to the Web Portal provides Family Services of Chemung County with a detailed picture of a patient's medical history through a comprehensive community health record. This community record brings together data on past medical encounters, immunizations, medications, test results, and specific medical conditions recorded in a patient's medical history.

The location of Chemung County is on the outer edge of the HealthlinkNY region. The HealthlinkNY Web Portal's Statewide Patient Record Lookup feature connects health information from providers across the state regardless of region. This means that no matter where in New York State that a patient has received care, their provider at Chemung County Family Services can query their complete electronic health record from anywhere across the state. Health Quest Goes Live with an Inbound C-CDA Connection to the HIE

Health Quest Systems, Inc. of the Hudson Valley has recently completed yet another phase of data contribution to the HIE with the go-live of an inbound C-

CDA connection to HealthlinkNY. Health Quest has already been sending their patient lab and radiology results and admission/discharge/transfer data to the HIE through the second half of 2015. A C-CDA connection allows for a direction communication between the HIE and Health Quest's Electronic Health Record (EHR) system, where they capture and maintain their patient records. The addition of this C-CDA connection provides other physicians accessing the HIE with a more comprehensive patient history and encounter overview for their patients who have visited Health Quest facilities. With this inbound connection complete, Health Quest will now begin the final stages of exchanging health information by implementing an outbound C-CDA connection to allow community-wide patient records to be sent from the HIE directly back into their EHR.


HAPN: Population Health Improvement Plan

Behavioral Health and Social Determinants of Health were chosen as the two areas of focus for the Hudson Valley



PHIP. These two work groups have already formed and begun work. The need for coordination of care and integration of behavioral health and primary care was discussed repeatedly as a critical issue by the PHIP steering committee and in our stakeholder interviews as was the need for acceptance of mental health as a public health problem. Although the Hudson Valley region as a whole may enjoy a relatively comfortable sense of well-being, significant pockets of low income, high unemployment, poverty, lack of public transportation, poor access to fresh fruits and vegetables, and cultural barriers indicate that inequality is alive and well. As noted in the 2015 SocioNeeds Index of both the HAPN Southern Tier and HAPN Hudson Valley regions mapped below, very few zip codes are without need.

HAPN Southern Tier is currently implementing 20 consumer driven focus groups that will be used in conjunction with the 200 stakeholder interviews across 5 counties.
